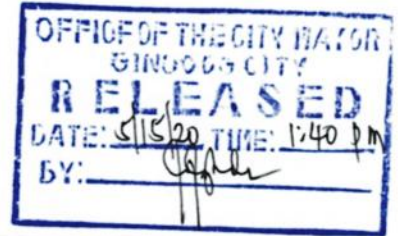

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 33
Series of 2020.

AN ORDER EXTENDING FURTHER THE DECLARATION OF THE GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE IN THE ENTIRE CITY OF GINGOOG UP TO MAY 31, 2020 PURSUANT TO THE MANDATE OF THE INTER-AGENCY TASK FORCE (IATF) FOR LOW-RISK AREAS.

WHEREAS, the President has placed the entire country under the State of Public Health Emergency due to the alarming threats posed by the Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) through Proclamation No. 922

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, President Rodrigo R. Duterte has declared a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to Coronavirus disease through Proclamation No. 929;

WHEREAS, on the noon of March 21, 2020, the entire City of Gingoog was placed under General Community Quarantine through Executive Order No. 21 series of 2020 and was extended by Executive Order No. 26 series of 2020 and was further extended by Executive Order No. 28 series of 2020 up to May 15, 2020;

WHEREAS, on May 11, 2020, the Inter-Agency Task Force through Resolution No. 35 series of 2020, has classified Misamis Oriental and the rest of Northern Mindanao as one of the "low risk" areas wherein it was first announced that it will no longer be under a community quarantine starting May 16, 2020;

WHEREAS, on May 13, 2020, the City Government of Gingoog through the Office of the City Mayor has appealed to Secretary Eduardo M. Año of the DILG as chairman of the Inter-Agency Task Force requesting to retain the General Community Quarantine in Gingoog City after May 15, 2020;

WHEREAS, on May 14, 2020, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) has announced that by virtue of IATF Resolution No. 35-A series of 2020, beginning May 16, 2020, Provinces, Highly Urbanized Cities (HUCs) and Independent Component Cities (ICCs) classified as low-risk based on their risk level shall be placed under General Community Quarantine;

WHEREAS, in compliance with the said Resolution, it is imperative upon the city government to extend further the declaration of the General Community Quarantine in the entire City of Gingoog.

NOW, THEREFORE, I ERICK G. CAÑOSA, by the virtue of the power vested in me by law as City Mayor of Gingoog, do hereby issue this Executive Order and declare the following:

Section 1: DECLARATION. It is hereby ordered to extend further the effectivity of Executive Order No. 21 series of 2020 declaring General Community Quarantine in the entire City of Gingoog up to May 31, 2020.

- a. The Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of the Community Quarantine issued by the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Disease (IATF-MEID) specifically on Section 3 thereof on the Guidelines for Areas under General Community Quarantine is hereby adopted and shall be made an integral part hereof;
- b. All other issuances or resolutions that have been issued or to be issued by the IATF with regards to the implementation of the General Community Quarantine are also deemed adopted and shall also be made an integral part of this Order;
- c. Moreover, the provisions of the following orders, which are not inconsistent with the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of the Community Quarantine and other IATF resolutions, shall likewise be extended up to May 31, 2020, to wit:
 1. The order establishing Check-Points in various strategic locations in the City to prevent the spread of COVID-19 under Executive Order No. 18 series of 2020;
 2. The order to strictly implement the new city-wide curfew hours from 8 pm to 4 am and other guidelines to prevent the spread of COVID-19 to be enforced in the entire City of Gingoog under Executive Order No. 20 series of 2020 which includes the Liquor Ban;
 3. The order imposing a 12-hour curfew for all minors in the entire City of Gingoog from 5pm to 5am under Executive Order No. 23 series of 2020.
- d. The following orders shall continue to take effect:
 1. The order of suspension of classes in all levels in both private and public schools under Executive Order No. 17 series of 2020 shall remain in effect subject to the guidelines set forth by the IATF under Resolution Nos. 30 and 34 series of 2020 on the limited operations of Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) and the opening of classes for the basic education;
 2. The order mandating every person within the territorial jurisdiction of Gingoog City to wear facemask at all times when going out of their residences, at the workplace, entering

government offices and while in public places under Executive Order No. 25 series of 2020 shall continue to be in full force and effect until the State of Public Health Emergency shall be lifted or withdrawn by the President or by other higher authorities. The mandatory wearing of facemask is also provided under City Ordinance No. 2020-353;

- e. The provisions of City Government of Gingoog Guidelines numbers 1 to 5 for the prevention of coronavirus disease (COVID-19) which do not conflict with the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of the Community Quarantine, IATF resolutions, other existing orders and guidelines shall continue to take force and effect unless declared otherwise by this office or by higher authorities.

Section 2: PENALTY CLAUSE: Any violations hereof shall be dealt with under existing laws and ordinances.

Section 3: REPEALING CLAUSE: Any Executive Order not consistent herewith is hereby amended or repealed.

Section 4: SEPARABILITY CLAUSE: In case any provision of this Order shall be declared invalid, illegal or unenforceable by higher authorities or by the Courts, the validity, legality, and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not in any way be affected or impaired.

Section 5: EFFECTIVITY: This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
