**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 37**  
Series of 2020.

**AN ORDER PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES AND AMENDMENTS IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A MODIFIED GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE IN THE CITY OF GINGOOG AS PROVIDED UNDER EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 34 SERIES OF 2020.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 15 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution, it is the policy of state to protect and promote the right to health of the people;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 16 of the Local Government Code (LGC) of 1991 or the General Welfare Clause, Local Government Units within their territorial jurisdiction shall promote the health and safety of the people;

**WHEREAS**, Section 455 (b) (vii) of the Local Government Code provides that for efficient, effective and economical governance the purpose of which is the general welfare of the city and its inhabitants the city mayor has the power to carry out such emergency measures as may be necessary during and in the aftermath of man-made and natural disasters and calamities;

**WHEREAS**, on May 29, 2020, by virtue of Executive Order No. 34, series of 2020, the entire City of Gingoog was placed under Modified General Community Quarantine effective June 1, 2020, up to June 15, 2020;

**WHEREAS**, as of June 13, 2020, there are already 25,392 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in the country and there are 1,074 fatalities reported by the DOH and the number of confirmed cases continue to surge;

**WHEREAS**, just today, Gingoog City has recorded the first two confirmed cases of COVID-19, a 30-year old male, and a 1-year old female who are both locally stranded individuals from Tondo, Manila and who have arrived in the city on June 11, 2020. Both of them are under strict observation and monitoring at the City Isolation Unit at Pangasihán, Gingoog City;

**WHEREAS**, considering all these new developments, the City through the COVID-19 Task Force, shall impose additional measures to prevent the spread of coronavirus disease (COVID-19) in the City.

**NOW THEREFORE, I ERICK G. CAÑOSA**, by the virtue of the power vested in me by law as City Mayor of Gingoog, do hereby issue this Executive Order and declare the following:

**Section 1: Declaration.** It is hereby ordered to provide for additional guidelines and impose some amendments in the implementation of the Modified General Community Quarantine in the entire City of Gingoog. The following are the additional and amended guidelines to be imposed in the city until further notice, to wit:

- a. **MOVEMENTS OF PERSONS.** As per IATF Resolution No. 43 series of 2020, the movement of all persons in areas placed under MGCQ shall be limited to accessing essential goods and services, for work in the office or industries permitted to operate and for other activities permitted under the omnibus guidelines.
- b. **QUARANTINE CHECK-POINTS.** With the approval from the Provincial Director of the PNP-Misamis Oriental, the established quarantine check-points located in Barangays San Luis, Pangasihan, and Kahulogan, Brgy. 26 manned by the members of the COVID-19 Task Force and the PNP shall continue its operation. The Travel requirements set forth by the DILG and the IATF shall be implemented at the said check-points, if applicable.
- c. **LIQUOR BAN.** Effective June 15, 2020, selling and possession of liquor and other alcoholic/intoxicating beverages shall be allowed from 5am to 6pm only. However, drinking and consumption of liquor and other alcoholic/intoxicating beverages shall be prohibited at all times outside residences and in all public places including KTV bars, resto-bars, restaurants, and other similar establishments.
- d. **OPERATION OF PAHAYAHAY SA PANTALAN AND RIZAL PARK.** Effective June 15, 2020, the Pahayahay sa Pantalan and Rizal Park shall be open to the public from 5am to 6pm only. This is to allow the conduct of all physical fitness and other activities in the area but subject to strict compliance of the minimum health standards set by the IATF.
- e. **CURFEW HOURS FOR MINORS.** The new curfew hours for minors shall be from 5pm to 5am.



**Section 2: Penalty Clause:** Any violations hereof shall be dealt with under existing laws and ordinances.

**Section 3: Repealing Clause:** Any Executive Order not consistent with this Order is hereby amended or repealed accordingly.

**Section 4: Separability Clause:** In case any provision of this Order shall be declared invalid, illegal or unenforceable by higher authorities or by the Courts, the validity, legality, and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not in any way be affected or impaired.

**Section 5: Effectivity:** This Executive Order shall take effect on the date and time abovementioned.
